## Steps for self-enrollment for NEW participants:

- Click on "log in" in the upper right hand corner.
- 2. Click create new account
- 3. Fill out all necessary information.
- 4. Log into your e-mail and confirm new account.
- 5. Go back to <u>www.cccelearningtrain.com</u> and log in.
- Scroll to bottom and select the blue folder labeled "Health and Safety Basic Courses for Early Childhood Programs".
- 7. Select the very top header. It will read "Health and Safety Basics" in red.
- 8. Click the blue box that says "Enroll me".
- You are now able to choose, on the right hand side under the folder "Current course", which Health and Safety Course you wish to take.

## Steps for self-enrollment for <u>RETURNING</u> participants:

- Using your username and password, log onto the website: www.cccelearningtrain.com.
- Scroll down on the home page to see the title Courses.
- Under this title you will see a group of file folders. Choose the area you want to take a class in and click on it.
- 4. Choose the course that you would like to take and begin.
- \* Once you complete all requirements for the course, print your certificate. You must receive a score of 80 or higher in order to receive your certificate.
- \* There is no time limit to take and complete courses, except for the last month of the quarter. During this time period, you will have a closing date so that the course can be finalized and closed to start a new quarter.
